





# WAHID

WAHID zawiera dane, które zostały przesłane przez państwa członkowskie OIE (Światowej Organizacji Zdrowia Zwierząt) poprzez system WAHIS (World Animal Health Information System), tj.:

- ✓ tzw. „szybkie notyfikacje” („immediate notification” oraz „follow-up reports”);
- ✓ raporty półroczne;
- ✓ raporty roczne.

Raporty po przekazaniu systemem WAHIS są weryfikowane i zatwierdzane przez OIE, a następnie publikowane w ogólnodostępnej internetowej bazie danych WAHID. OIE może wprowadzać zmiany do raportów przed ich publikacją.

Obowiązki państw członkowskich OIE w zakresie notyfikacji chorób określone są w:

# **WAHID – choroby zwierząt lądowych i wodnych**

Zgodnie z Kodeksami OIE, państwo członkowskie ma również obowiązek przysyłać systemem WAHIS do OIE raporty półroczne i roczne.

Raporty półroczne zawierają jedynie dane na temat występowania chorób z listy OIE, natomiast raporty roczne dodatkowo zawierają m.in. informację na temat:

- występowania chorób spoza listy OIE;
- występowania zoonoz u ludzi;
- populacji zwierząt;
- personelu weterynaryjnego;
- krajowych laboratoriów referencyjnych;
- testów diagnostycznych wykonywanych przez te laboratoria;
- producentów i produkcji szczepionek.



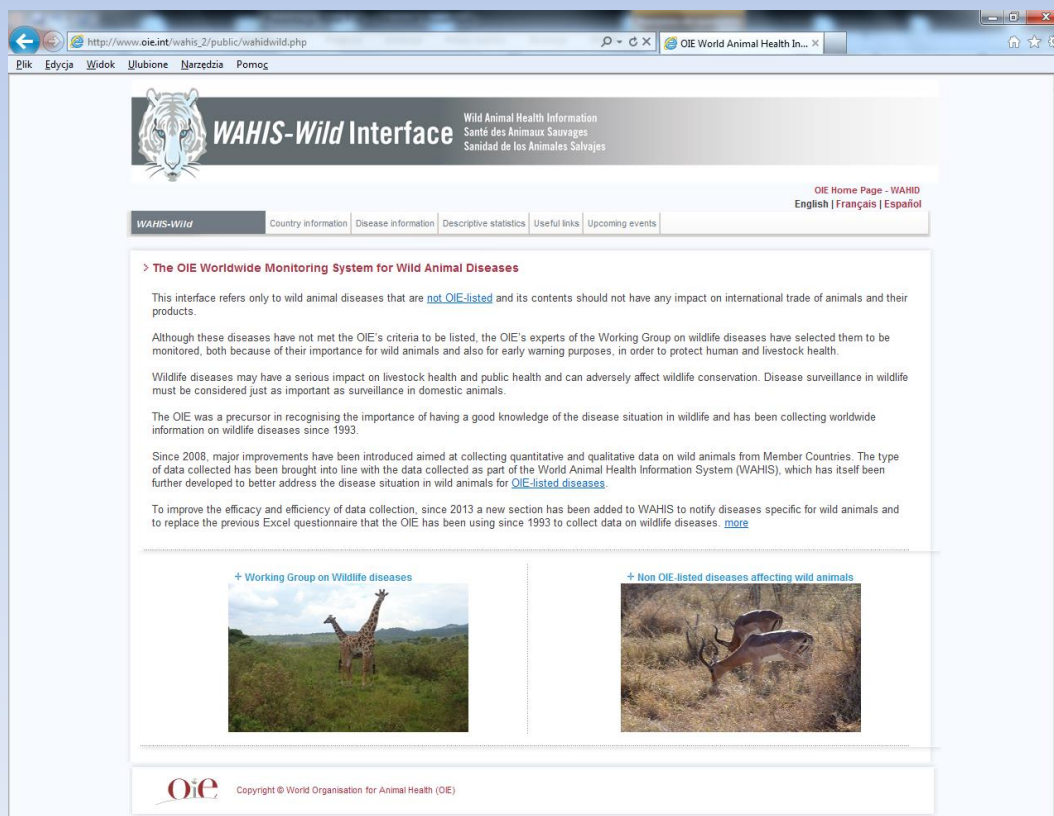

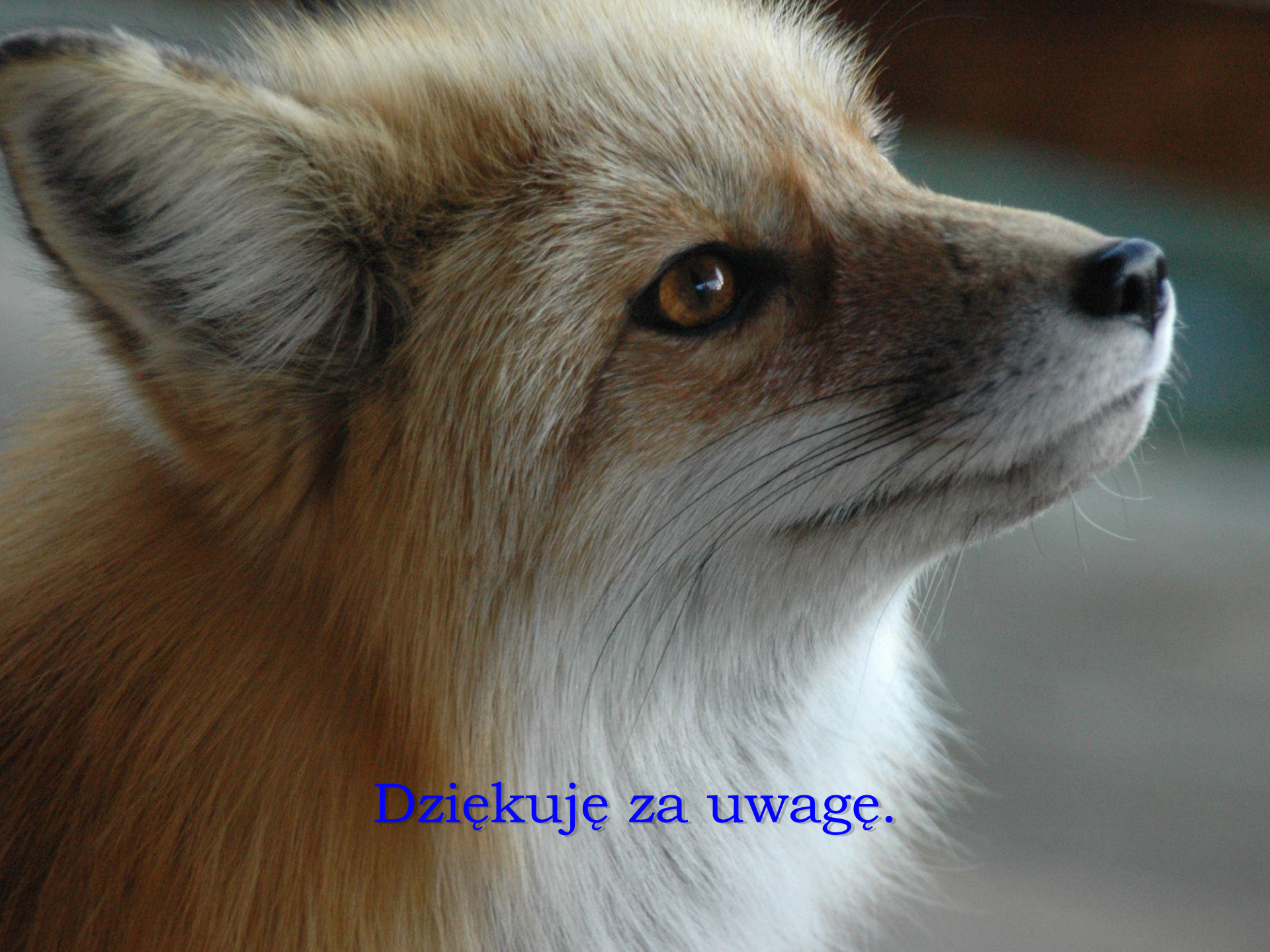
